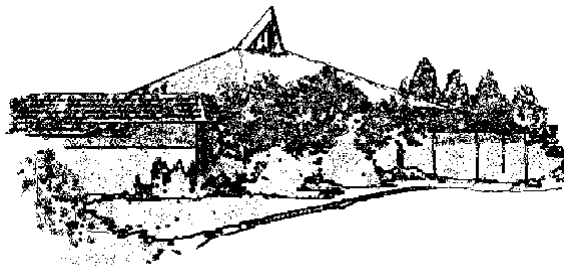
Church Needs
