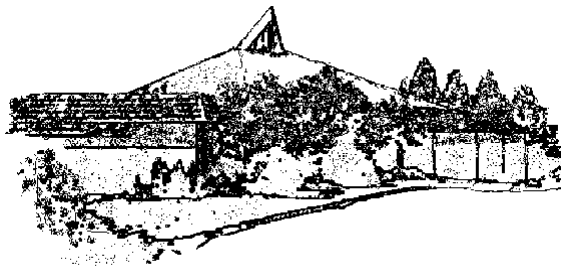
Church Needs
