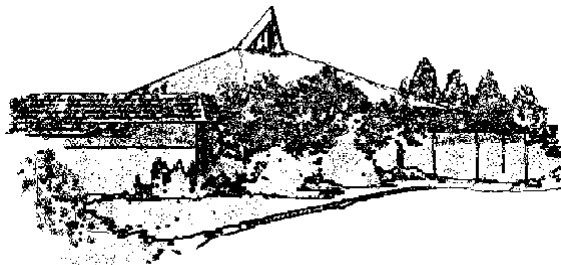
## *Church Needs*
