Welcome Back!

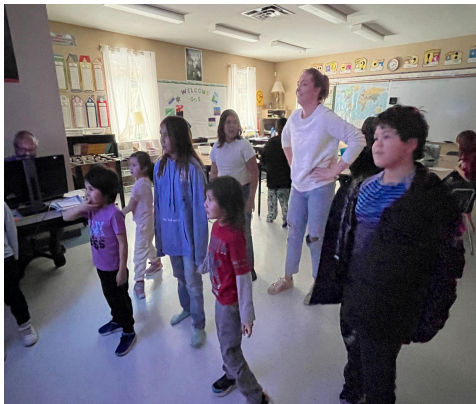
