STEWARDSHIP: The word has received a negative reputation in the mind of many believers. It is introduced at the tithe and offering phase of our worship experience when it is much more than a liturgical segment in worship. When you hear or think of the word "Stewardship," don't cringe and hide your wallets or purses. In prior presentations, the focus of stewardship was, not intentionally, transactional (about money only), instead of transformational (spiritually balanced).
