Selected Readings:

The Lamb Takes the Scroll

1 And I saw in the right hand of Him who sat on the throne a scroll written inside and on the back, sealed with seven seals. Then I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, "Who is worthy to open the scroll and to loose its seals?" 3 And no one in heaven or on the earth or under the earth was able to open the scroll, or to look at it. 4 So I wept much, because no one was found worthy to open and read the scroll, or to look at it. 5 But one of the elders said to me, "Do not weep. Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has prevailed to open the scroll and to loose its seven seals."

An angel carrying a scroll sealed with seven seals calls out, "Who is worthy to open the seals?" (Revelation 5:2). In dismay, John the Revelator initially sees no one worthy to break the seals and open the scroll. As he looks at the throne, John rejoices to see a Lamb that had been slain but is now alive—majestic, powerful, Spirit-filled. This represents the eternal Jesus who rescues humanity from the tyranny of Satan, thus providing us the gift of salvation. Because of the Lamb of God, you and I can celebrate the ultimate victory of God over sin. Indeed, "Blessing and honor and glory and power be to Him who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb, forever and ever!" (Revelation 5:13).{JTL 3 3-4}

There in His open hand lay the book, the roll of the history of God's providences, the prophetic history of nations and the church. Herein was contained the divine utterances, His authority, His commandments, His laws, the whole symbolic counsel of the Eternal, and the history of all ruling powers in the nations. In symbolic language was contained in that roll the influence of every nation, tongue, and people from the beginning of earth's history to its close.—Manuscript Releases, vol. 9, p. 7.

The cross of Christ brings us nigh to God, reconciling man to God, and God to man. . . . The cross has been almost lost sight of, but without the cross there is no connection with the Father, no unity with the Lamb in the midst of the throne in heaven, no welcome reception of the wandering who would return to the forsaken path of righteousness and truth, no hope for the transgressor in the day of judgment. Without the cross there is no means provided for overcoming the power of our strong foe. Every hope of the race hangs upon the cross.—Our High Calling, p. 46.
