The Deity of Christ

Alongside these declarations on Christ's true and genuine humanity, something of the place assigned to Jesus in early Christian belief may be gained from a study of the names and titles which Jesus Himself used or others gave Him. Though the titles listed here do not amount to a systematic presentation of Jesus' person and mission, they undoubtedly make an important contribution toward it. Gospel writers used titles to indicate His deity.
