

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Welcome to Midland Adventist Academy's Athletic Department. We are honored that you are encouraging your child to participate in our sports program. Please take a minute to read the following information.

Midland's athletic program strives to uphold our school's mission "developing passionate followers of Christ who love God and serve people." We can make this year a success as we work together to encourage our student athletes to uphold Christian standards in and out of the athletic area. We want to represent Christ to our community through athletics. We have a long tradition of Christian sportsmanship and we will continue this tradition as we uphold our high standards.

Our athletic program would not exist without parent volunteers. Each athlete's parents are asked to pay an athletic fee or sign up for volunteer slots throughout the season to aid in subsidizing that fee. Volunteer slots are found in a red folder in the gym office see Coach Liepke.

You have **two options** for the Midland Athletic Sports Fee.

Option One:

Varsity Basketball Sports Fee: \$275 (\$200 for multiple athletes per family) per sport for parents/guardians who decide not to volunteer.

Junior High Sports Fee: \$175 (\$125 for multiple athletes per family) per sport for parents/guardians who decide not to volunteer.

Option Two:

The High School Sports Fee is reduced to \$125 when a parent/guardian volunteers for home game work slots. *Generally there are 4 slots per first athlete and ADD 2 for multiple athletes per sport.*

The Junior High Sports Fee is reduced to \$75 when a parent/guardian volunteers for home game work slots. *Generally there are 3 slots per first athlete and ADD 1 for multiple athletes per sport.*

If you would like to volunteer, but there are scheduling conflicts, see the Athletic Director for alternative volunteer work soon as options are limited.

To function within the safety policy of our conference, students will be required to ride to and from all athletic events on the bus, with a coach who has driving clearances, or with a parent. Athletes will not be allowed to drive themselves to away events. They can drive to our school, but as a school sponsored event, students must be transported by staff or parent within this policy.

Uniforms must be taken care of. Please wash and strictly adhere to washing instructions. Store them in a safe place. Please return them to your coach in the manner he/she requests. Failure to return them in the condition they were given, or complete failure to return, will result in your account being charged for the full replacement price of \$80.

Athlete Agreement 2024/2025

As a student athlete, I understand that the following is expected of me. Failure to follow the team rules could result in suspension or release from the team.

1. Show respect for authority to the officials of the game and of the opposition.
2. Demonstrate good sportsmanship before, during, and after games.
3. Display a positive attitude toward all members of the team, including coaches and parents.
4. Be courteous of opposing teams and treat all players and coaches with respect.
5. Be modest when successful and gracious in defeat.
6. Respect the privilege of the use of facilities and equipment.
7. All student athletes must pass a KSHSAA physical examination and have a copy on file with the AD.
8. Uphold MAA student Conduct Guidelines in the MAA handbook.
9. A student athlete will immediately become ineligible and could lose all playing privileges for that season or sport for any of the following reasons:
 - A. Smoking, drinking, and or the use of illegal drugs.
 - B. Acting in a manner than may bring dishonor to the community or school.
 - C. Fighting or coming off the bench or sideline during any on court conflict
10. Show up to all team functions on time, including: practices, games and team activities. If unable to show up, it is imperative to notify a coach by text, phone call, or email as soon as possible. (Please note: excused absences by MAA or coach may affect your game time). The reason is that we need to develop teamwork. If you are not at practice, you will miss an opportunity to develop teamwork. Also, each person needs to be held accountable for his or her actions and choices on and off the court.
11. Students Athletes will be required to ride to and from all athletic events on the bus, with a coach who has driving clearances, or with a parent.
12. All participants (athletes, team managers, and helpers) must maintain a 2.0 GPA or higher. Should a sports participant receive an incomplete, an F or more than one D on the most recent grade report, he/she will be ineligible to participate (practice and play games) until the following grade quarter when grades will be assessed again. Grades will be assessed at the first 4 ½ weeks grading period and then every quarter thereafter.
13. MAA has put policies in place for sports to reduce the risk of becoming infected with COVID-19. Despite the schools best efforts, there is still a chance that you could be exposed to COVID-19
