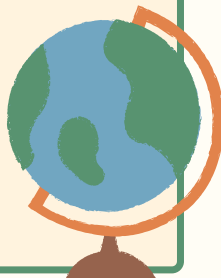
### Talent Show

## A Note From the Principal

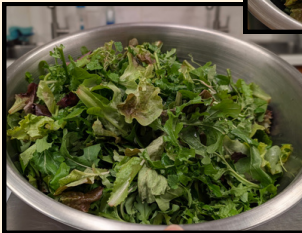
Greetings everyone!

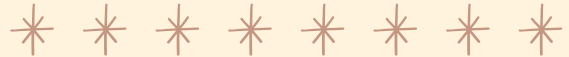


## Dish Washers Needed

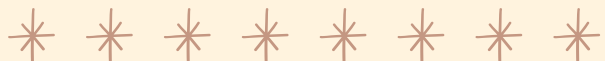
If your child cannot attend please notify the teacher asap as rehearsals have started and we are assigning parts.

Our Home and School team worked many hours to make the photo sessions possible last Sunday. Pastor Gio gave up his one potential day off to take pictures. We appreciate everyone's generous service. Thank you to those of you who also supported the event.

**Home and School Goals  
and Accomplishments**

Our Home and School team want to keep you informed about our goals and how we are meeting them. The team votes for any expenditures to ensure accountability and transparency. We want to keep you informed about what you are helping us accomplish.

Our primary goal for Fall Festival is to have fun, and we try to enable participation with minimal expense to families. We did, however, profit about \$480. \$831.32 was raised for the baked goods auction which is designated for the expansion project. You also helped the eighth graders with their fundraising through the "jail". They earned \$139.50.

The photo event raised \$380 before expenses. We are still doing some calculations to determine the profit.

Your Home and School team has funded menstrual kits for all our girls in grades 5-8, which were graciously put together by Mrs. Hayes. We have purchased a new sound system that will serve both indoor and outdoor activities. Mr. and Mrs. Anderson installed it at no cost to us. How very blessed we are by people who care.

Our leadership team has voted to fund the following projects for the school through this year's activities: We will buy two large chafing pans and a large quality food processor for the kitchen. We have decided that the Color Run proceeds will go toward repaving the parking lot. Other projects are under consideration.
