### World Vision

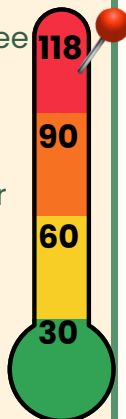
We currently raise money for three World Vision children; Srey Aun, Nura & Samba.

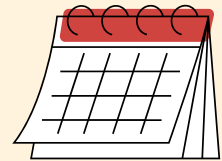
## Thank You From Split Rock
