Permission slips will be going out today and will need to be signed and returned in order for students to attend.

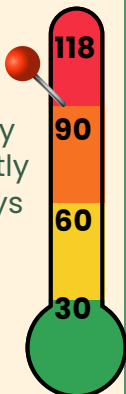
Lunch will be provided by Union Springs Academy.
