**We have exceeded our goal for the month of April by raising \$145.75!**

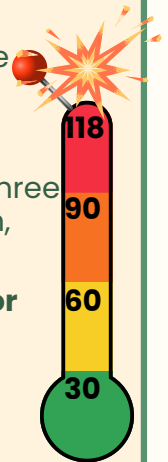
