From Pastor's Desk

The Scripture for today is: Psalm 37:4-6

Delight yourself also in the **LORD**, and He shall give you the desires of your heart. Commit your way to the **LORD**, trust also in Him, and He shall bring forth righteousness as the light, and your justice as the noonday.

The desires and aspirations of the righteous flow from their relationship with God. That relationship is their primary relationship and from it everything else is conceived. When our relationship with God is right, all other relationships and aspirations will be right also because they are determined by our primary relationship. When God is first and foremost in all of our desires, the direction for our life is established in Him. The desires of our hearts will be granted because those desires are products of hearts that are surrendered to God and lives that are in loving fellowship with Him. We put no confidence in the flesh or in fleshly desires. We, through the direction of the Holy Spirit who resides in us, are led to please the LORD. That is our primary desire and all other desires are subordinate to it. As we grow in grace, we grow in our desire to be pleasing to God in everything. Not some things, but in everything. Pleasing God is our heart's desire and all of our aspirations are found in that desire. May we be forever devoted to Him and may our hearts be His home. "The godly man never indulges a desire which he cannot form into a prayer to God." *Adam Clark* Pause and think on that.
