

# Why Expand?

For several years now we have been at or around maximum capacity for our little school. This year the upper grade classroom is at 13 & the lower grade classroom is at 16 with five 4th graders planning to move up to 5th grade next year.

With increased enrollment comes more books and desks and supplies. The Fellowship Hall of the church is our "music room" for practicing chimes, but we run into conflicts with Pathfinders and meetings. We have also reached our capacity in our library.

So in May of this year a committee was set up to look into our options for enlarging our school. At about the same time, we found out that an 8-acre parcel of land adjacent to the school field along Rt. 140 was for sale. An idea for a school building was drawn up, and that is what you see pictured in this brochure.

We have divided this project into 3 phases. Phase 1 will be the purchase of the land. Phase 2 is a gym, 3 classrooms, office, music room, & library. And Phase 3 is the completed building which will have enough room for Gr. 9-10.

The land will not become available for purchase until February 2025. The cost would be \$600,000. Donations have already been pledged in the amount of \$100,000. So that leaves \$500,000 left to raise.

And that is where you come in. We hope you will be as excited as we are and join us in this new journey.

## Phase 1

Purchase the land for \$600,000.

## Phase 2

Build the gymnasium with a kitchen at the back. School office & library/music room will be in the front. Three classrooms and a lunch room will be on the left. The school will be Pre-K through Grade 8. This is projected to be about 3 million dollars.



## Phase 3

Add the classrooms on the right and the library and music room at the back. The school will now be Pre-K through Grade 10. This is projected to be another about 3 million dollars
