Student Edition

The Student Edition constitutes the main tool for the *InterKulturell* Program. The Level 1 Student Edition contains 6 units plus a preliminary unit. Each unit is comprised of the following sections.

- **Interkulturelle Begegnung:** Introduction to a German-speaking country or region through a native-speaker vlogger from that region. Students will repeatedly interact with the unit vlogger, building intercultural competence.
- **Wir kommunizieren 1, 2, 3:** Communicative section related to the unit theme with specific vocabulary, grammar, and culture focus.
 - **Wie sagt man das?** Introduction of thematic vocabulary and expressions in context. Students learn and apply words they will need for communicative tasks.
 - **Sprache entdecken:** Inductive approach to grammar in context. Students notice patterns, test hypotheses, and apply language structures to support communication.
 - **Fokus Kultur:** Presentation of cultural products or practices through perspectives to develop intercultural reflection through cultural comparison.
 - **Unterwegs:** Formative checkpoints for reflection and self-assessment. Students monitor their progress with Can-Do statements, self-assess, and identify areas for improvement.
- **Unsere globale Gemeinschaft:** Projects and tasks that connect classroom learning to German-speaking communities and global themes. Students investigate communities, research perspectives, and apply language skills in authentic, real-world projects, building real-life skills for future opportunities.
- **Ziel erreicht!:** Unit Summative Assessment (Integrated Performance Assessment, IPA). Students demonstrate performance and reflect on what they can do with the language at this stage of proficiency.

Workbook: Grammar and Vocabulary Practice activities to provide reinforcement of key unit content through exercises.

Nualang: Interactive and playful digital environment to practice speaking, listening, and pronunciation of German

Unit Goals: Connect letters to sounds, identify words that are similar in German and English, read and listen to short texts about someone's family and interests, and follow classroom commands; Exchange personal information such as phone numbers and birthdays; Tell someone which school supplies you have and make a list; Investigate where German is spoken, the connections between the German and English languages, traditions related to starting school, and typical holidays in Germany.
